





- Paper (you can either print the worksheet or colour on a blank piece of paper if you do not have a printer.













These are the colours that cannot be made from mixing any other colours



# Warm and Cool Colours




#### Complementary Colours

Complementary colours used together in artwork can create a really powerful and vibrant look










#### Analagous Colours

Analogous colour schemes use colours that are next to each other on the colour wheel. They usually match well and create serene and comfortable designs.

Analogous colour schemes are often found in nature and are harmonious and pleasing to the eye.

Make sure you have enough contrast when choosing an analogous colour scheme.

Choose one colour to dominate, a second to support. The third colour is used (along with black, white or gray) as an accent.

The most common color schemes are listed below.

Primary.... {I can make all the other colors by mixing different amounts of primary colors

Secondary.... {I can mix two primary colors to make a secondary color.

Narm... {Yellow and all the colors with red and orange tones are warm.

Complimentary.... The and green tones are cool.

{Opposites on the color wheel are complimentary.}

Analogous... and so on.

Quinbow... Susing primary and secondary Color's placed in order from the colorwheel, I can make a rainbow

Intermediate ... is a color term I need to know. It is the color in between the primary and secondary colors on the color wheel.
